Homework Policy – Morning Sun Community School District encourages students to make responsible decisions concerning their own behavior. Students are expected to be responsible for completing the assigned, written work on time. This homework policy is designed to help students keep an organized record of their work and will provide extra work time for students unable to complete work on their own.

- Students will be responsible for a daily record of assignments.
- Parents will be notified when assignments are not completed on time.
- Students will be held responsible for following their classroom's individual homework policies.
- Students with 3 incomplete assignments will serve a 30-minute detention after school. Bus students will be given one day prior notice in order to arrange transportation.

The goal of the detention period is to allow students to complete assignments in a structured, businesslike atmosphere. This will prevent them from falling behind in their academic work. Teachers will be available to assist students as needed. If, after a period of time, this detention is not proving effective, we may need to meet to discuss other ways to encourage the students to be responsible decision-makers.
